SEDAR 68 OA, Gulf of Mexico Scamp, Operational Assessment

Summary: The Gulf of Mexico Scamp Operational Assessment was completed August 31, 2022. The assessment is slated to be reviewed by the GMFMC SSC at its September 2022 meeting.

SEDAR 78 South Atlantic Spanish Mackerel, Operational Assessment

Summary: The Operational Assessment of South Atlantic Spanish Mackerel is underway. The Stock Assessment report was released May 2022 and revised July 2022. The SAFMC SSC reviewed the assessment in August 2022.

SEDAR 68 OA, Atlantic Scamp, Operational Assessment

Summary: The Atlantic Scamp Operational Assessment is underway. The Terms of Reference and Schedule were approved by the SAFMC in December 2021. No Topical Working Groups are being organized for this assessment. The Assessment is scheduled to be completed in November 2022.

SEDAR 74 Gulf of Mexico Red Snapper, Research Track

Summary:

The Data Workshop was held in Gulfport, MS May 2-6, 2022. Additional data webinars were held May-August. Discard Mortality webinars were held before and after the Data Workshop and will be completed in October of 2022. Assessment webinars will be held

between September 2022 and January 2023, and the Review Workshop is slated for April 2023. The assessment is scheduled to be completed in May 2023.

SEDAR 75 Gulf of Mexico Gray Snapper, Operational Assessment

Summary: The Gulf of Mexico Gray Snapper Operational Assessment is underway.

There were two Topical Working Groups associated with this assessment. The Life History TWG held webinars December 2021 and June 2022. The Shore Mode TWG met via webinar in June and July 2022. The assessment should be completed by November 2022.

SEDAR 76 South Atlantic Black Sea Bass, Operational Assessment

Summary: The Terms of Reference for the South Atlantic Black Sea Bass Operational Assessment were approved by the SAFMC in June 2020. The original Project Schedule and participants list were approved by the SAFMC in September 2020. Due to a delay brought on by Covid-19 the schedule was adjusted to start with data scoping in May 2022. The updated schedule was reviewed by the SAFMC in March 2021. The terminal year of data is 2020. The Data scoping webinar was held May 2022. More Assessment webinars will be held September 2022 through January 2023. The scheduled completion date is March 2023.

SEDAR 77 HMS Hammerhead Sharks, Research Track (4 Stocks)

Summary: The HMS Hammerheads Sharks Research Track assessment is currently underway. The Data process is completed and the report was released in April 2022. The Assessment process is underway with three webinars completed and three more scheduled for September 2022 through November 2022. The Review Workshop is scheduled for March 2023. The assessment is scheduled to be released to NOAA: HMS April 2023.

SEDAR 79 Southeastern US Mutton Snapper, Benchmark

Summary: The Benchmark assessment for SE US Mutton Snapper has been rescheduled for 2023. The terminal year of data for the assessment will be 2022. Data Scoping will be held April 2023, with a Data Workshop scheduled for August 21-25, 2023. Assessment webinars will be held from November 2023 to April 2024. The Review Workshop is scheduled for July 9-11, 2024.

SEDAR 80 Caribbean Queen Triggerfish, Operational Assessment (3 management units)

Summary: The Operational Assessment of Caribbean Queen triggerfish is partially complete. There were three Topical Working Groups (TWGs) to review life history information, discuss the possibility of developing an index of abundance, and discuss the effect of regulations and economy on fishing behavior/selectivity, retention, and catchability.

The Final Stock Assessment Report for Queen Triggerfish in Puerto Rico was released on 20 July 2022. The CFMC SSC reviewed the assessment at their August 2022 meeting. The SSC had some concerns with the assessment and provided some guidance on ways to improve the assessment from their perspective. The SEFSC will provide feedback to the SSC at their October meeting.

The Final Stock Assessment Reports for Queen Triggerfish in St. Thomas/St. John and St. Croix have not yet been released.

SEDAR 81 Gulf of Mexico Spanish Mackerel, Operational Assessment

Summary: Terms of Reference for the 2022 Gulf of Mexico Spanish mackerel Operational Assessment were approved in October 2021. No Topical Working Groups are being organized for this assessment. Final analytical products are due in October 2022. The assessment is scheduled to be completed in February 2023.

SEDAR 82 South Atlantic Gray Triggerfish, Research Track

Summary: The Project Schedule, Terms of Reference, and participant list went to the SAFMC for final approval in December 2021. Three Data webinars have already occurred. The assessment is scheduled to be completed in December 2023.

Summary: Planning for the 2023 South Atlantic Vermilion Snapper Operational Assessment was completed. The Terms of Reference and Schedule were approved by the SAFMC in December 2021. No Topical Working Groups were scheduled to be organized for this assessment. The Assessment was scheduled to be completed in September 2023.
