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SEDAR Procedural Workshop 8: Fishery Independent Index Development Under Changing Survey Design Terms of Reference

- 1. Develop inventory of fishery-independent (FI) abundance surveys that have had issues with changing methodology or changes in spatial coverage through time that must be accounted for when constructing FI indices of abundance.
- 2. Review past assessments and document types of issues that arose when FI indices of abundance were combined or due to changing survey design. Possible issues may include:
 - Combining multiple surveys
 - Survey spatial expansion
 - Changing survey design
 - Adding new strata
- 3. Inventory and evaluate methods used in the past to handle issues and identify potential new methods to address them.
- 4. Recommend best practice procedures and approaches for addressing identified issues with FI indices of abundance for future assessments.
- 5. Prepare a SEDAR Procedural Workshop report addressing workshop recommendations and decisions that will be used to guide future SEDAR assessments.
 - Explore the development a flow chart or decision tree that would lead future data providers through the most common issues that arise when analyzing indices
