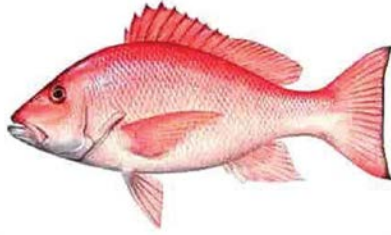

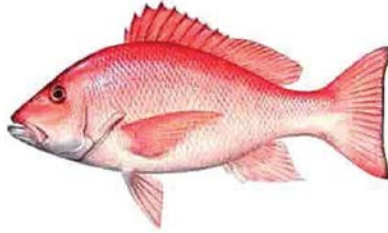

WARM weather and a calm ocean have brought out the deep sea anglers this week. They are getting good catches bottom fishing, but doing nothing with the trolls out and back.

Red snapper have been hungry all week. The cruiser Miss America out of Myers' Dock at the Inlet* brought in about 30 medium sized snapper Tuesday, running about four and five pounds.

Ed Wynder on the Kiltie brought in 23 of them Tuesday and those his party got were larger, one of them going up to 20 pounds and several over 10. Grouper and trigger fish were also in the catch.

The cruisers Dolphin and Marveia, too, have been having good luck this week on the party grounds, 21 Mile Bank. Yesterday the snapper catch was smaller than Tuesday's, but there were more grouper and rock bass. Several other parties are going out today.

The trolling, however, has gained nothing. It's still a little cold for those king mackerel, but with the sea warming up rapidly they should be coming in soon.

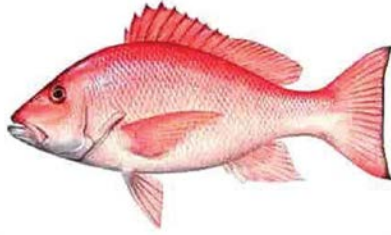

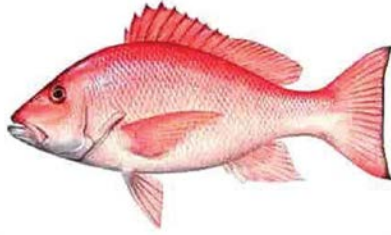

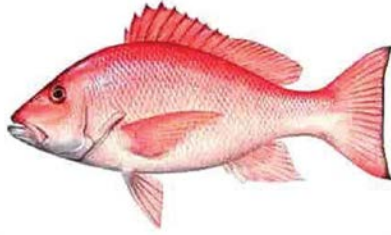

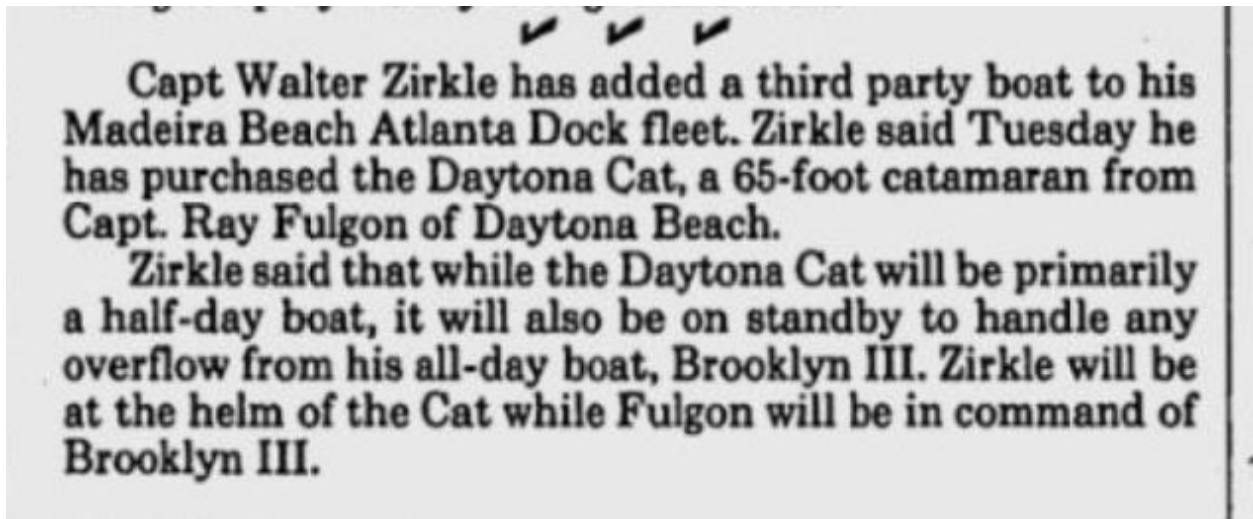

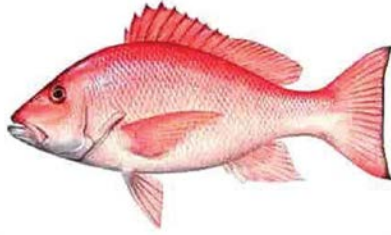
